

## **History of Father's Day**

The idea of Father's Day was conceived more than a century ago by Sonora Dodd of Spokane, Washington.

Dodd wanted a special day to honor her father, William Smart, a widowed Civil War veteran who was left to raise his six children on a farm.

June 19 was chosen for the first Father's Day celebration in 1910.

Father's Day has been celebrated annually since 1972 when President Richard Nixon signed the public law that made it permanent.

In Summer 2019, Parishioner Olabisi Longe joined with Monsignor Anselm Nwaorgu and other St. Michael's Church parishioners to create a charitable ministry. Their vision was to extend the Hand of Grace to the community -- both parishioners and non-parishioners, to provide needed basic daily items of necessity for mothers and children aged newborn to five years old. Currently, the HUGS Ministry serves approximately fifty families.

The Ministry is funded by the generosity of its fourteen active members and the parishioners. St. Michael's Parish Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) has also been very supportive, converting their Community Service Project to an annual HUGS Collection program. From time-to-time the Ministry also benefits from external support, including from the Union Township Knights of Columbus and Columbites, who supplement the daily items and also provide a large donation of brand new coats that go to as many children as possible.

The Ministry prepares and distributes "Grace Bags" monthly which contain basic items needed daily, including diapers, pull-ups, wipes, baby lotion, toothbrushes and toothpaste, deodorant, and items used for bathing including bath wash, bath soap, shampoo, and conditioner.

Two special annual collection events also provide additional support: "Back to School" in September, and "The Giving Tree" in December/January.

In addition to providing these greatly needed items, the parishioners also serve these mothers and their children with the utmost level of dignity, respect, empathy, and love.

The Ministry has also donated Grace Bags to the Union County Division of Social Services-Intake department, the Irvington Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit, and to help victims of the Hurricane Dorian in Puerto Rico in 2019.

#### **Union of Saints and Nations**

One of the pillars of the Knights of Columbus is Unity. You can find "unity" within the community," and we Knights are a community of Catholic men. The Union of Saints and Nations (USAN) is the one and only fundraiser at Saint Michael's Church. Although not every member of Council 4504 resides in Union or is a member of St. Michael Parish, we support all our various parishes. The mission of the Knights is to live our faith at home, in our parish, and in our community. None of us are as good as all of us.

Union Council supports the annual USAN fundraiser under the group name of Blessed Fr. Michael McGiveny, intending to raise \$2000.
